

NOHC Policy for scholarship dispersal

The expiration date of the scholarship award is two years from anticipated high school graduation as recorded at the time of scholarship award. The student can notify the grantors of changes in academic progress prior to the expiration date of the dispersal. When the dispersal request is made, the awardee will provide the name of school, mailing address and student ID number. A check will then be written out and mailed to the school. Check issuance will be based on NOHC financial policies. A copy of the check along with the letter sent to school will be made and kept on file at the NOHC.

The name of each awardee, along with amount of scholarship and when their eligibility ends will be kept on file at the NOHC.

The scholarship can be dispersed to any post secondary institution or program that trains and awards a certificate of proficiency to document technical or professional post secondary education. It is not intended to fund travel or experiential learning that does not provide credentials for a technical or professional career. The check will only be issued to an accredited institute of learning.
